

**Title:** Lead Engagement Specialist

**Departments:** Family Shelters

Supervisor: Family Pathways Program Director

# Job Summary:

Provide engagement with guests of our family shelters and leadership support to the Program Director. The shelters provide a safe and warm shelter for residents in 12 family rooms as well as 1 room for 4 single women. The Lead Engagement Specialist is responsible for providing resource brokering services including crisis intervention, conflict resolution, program oversight and staff support and other duties at a family emergency shelter.

# Summary of essential job functions and responsibilities:

- 1. Work opposite the Family Pathways Program Director between two family shelters.
- 2. Work with the Program Director, Housing Navigator, and other Engagement Specialists to ensure that the shelters are safe and welcoming to a broad diversity of families experiencing homelessness including people of all races, nationalities, languages, ages, abilities.
- 3. Provide basic intake and orientation to all new residents on a daily basis, including but not limited to reviewing shelter expectations.
- 4. Provide crisis response and conflict resolution by encouraging positive methods for problem solving.
- 5. Provide ongoing services to all shelter residents as detailed on their housing stability plan.
- 6. Provide resource brokering, clothing, blankets, bedding and other needed items in a fair and equitable manner to residents. Partner with community agencies to provide needed services to residents.
- 7. Notify police, fire, and emergency medical or other emergency personnel if warranted by events in the shelter.
- 8. Meet with supervisor and participate in department staff meetings and quarterly staff trainings.
- 9. Complete housing assessments with each resident.
- 10. Maintain accurate, complete, up-to-date daily documentation of residents served and their basic demographic information. Enter data into ServicePoint. Submit paperwork in a timely manner.
- 11. Process grievance and incident reports.
- 12. Participate in the 24/7 rotating on-call schedule for a week at a time every five weeks.

- 13. Record each shifts activity in the shift log book and review log book entries from last shifts.
- 14. Perform weekly room checks and submit reports of room conditions/needs to Program Director.
- 15. Develop and maintain a positive relationships with residents and other employees. Offer coaching to shelter staff as needed.
- 16. Help provide oversight and support to volunteers and community service workers in shelter.
- 17. Attend monthly staff meetings and trainings as assigned.
- 18. Other duties as assigned.

### **Minimum Qualifications:**

## **Experience:**

Position requires a minimum of one (2) years' experience in related field, specifically with people experiencing homelessness or low-income individuals. Experience in dealing with substance abuse, mental health concerns and crisis intervention desired. Supervisory experience is preferred.

## Knowledge and Skills:

- Social and economic issues creating poverty, working successfully with practices and techniques related to people with low income to achieve greater self- sufficiency.
- Knowledge of local social service resources/providers.
- · Understanding of the housing first model, harm reduction and strength based case management
- Effective problem-solving skills
- · Strong communication and interpersonal skills
- Proficient in written and oral communication
- Show strong leadership abilities
- Strong organizational skills and ability to follow through from beginning to end on tasks and projects
- Basic principles of confidentiality, crisis de-escalation, assertive engagement, and trauma informed care
- Be culturally sensitive to diverse client populations
- Prepare and maintain clear, accurate, complete and timely records'
- · Maintain strict confidentiality and professional boundaries with all clients served
- Understand and follow complex written and oral instructions, guidelines and procedures
- Work independently and at the same time be a vital and contributing part of a team.
