

Where do Share's In-kind Donations go?

At Share, we are often asked where all our in-kind donations go when they leave the warehouse. Below is a diagram, in words and pictures, listing the programs that benefit from your generous donations. Donations start their journey at the **Share Fromhold Service Center**. From there, they travel to ...



Share's Shelters for Women, Men & Families provide residents with personal and hygiene items during their stay, such as:

- toiletries: full-sized shampoo, conditioner, body wash, dental health items, deodorant, shaving items
- clothing: adult work clothes, underwear, bras, jeans, kids' clothes for school, shower shoes for kids & adults
- school supplies: backpacks & other basic supplies
- holidays & kids' birthdays: toys, sports equipment, books

Share's Move-Out Kits are given to people or families to help meet basic needs when they secure permanent housing. They include:

- cleaning products: laundry detergent, disinfecting wipes or sprays, dish soap, sponges, mops, brooms
- household: bedside lamps, garbage bins, toilet paper, paper towels, bath towels, wash cloths
- kitchen: pots, pans, dishes, glasses, silverware, napkins

Share's Housing Programs not only help people to secure housing, but to help overcome obstacles to maintaining their housing. This includes:

- toiletries: full-sized shampoo, conditioner, body wash, deodorant, dental health items, shaving items
- clothing: adult work clothes, kids' clothes for school, everyday shoes for kids & adults
- school supplies: backpacks & other basic supplies
- holidays & kids' birthdays: toys, sports equipment, books
- cleaning products: laundry detergent, disinfecting wipes or sprays, dish soap, sponges, mops, brooms
- household: bedside lamps, garbage bins, toilet paper, paper towels, bath towels, wash cloths
- kitchen: pots, pans, dishes, glasses, silverware, napkins

Share's Outreach Team distributes essential kits and high-need items to community members experiencing homelessness:

- hygiene kits: travel size shampoo, conditioner, body wash, deodorant, Q-tips, Chapstick
- period kits: small packs of tampons, pads, flushable wipes, travel size hand sanitizer
- food kits: non-perishable protein packed foods, snacks, drinks
- shelter items: tarps, sleeping bags, tent
- weather dependent: coats, rain ponchos, hats, gloves

Share Community Partners help to expand our reach in getting essential items into the hands of those who need them.

- personal and hygiene items to FCRCs in Clark County schools (diapers, clothing, period products, books for kids)
- resource sharing with other non-profits such as Council for the Homeless, YWCA Clark County, FISH, A Caring Closet, and many more
