Share's 'Make a House a Home' wish tags are a convenient way for community members to purchase and donate a highneed item for a child, teen, adult, or senior in our housing and outreach programs to be gifted during the holiday season in December or at any time throughout the year.

Find out more about Share's 'Make a House a Home' Wish Tag Program through the answers to commonly asked questions below:

Q. There are two items listed on my tag. Do I need to purchase both items?

A. Donors are free to choose just one of the two items, or both if they would like! It is not required to purchase both items.

Q. What if I cannot afford the item requested?

A. That's okay, as the items listed are merely suggestions. Every donation and gift is deeply appreciated.

Q. Can I donate a gift card?

A. We are enormously grateful for gift card donations, as we give them to clients to take the lead role in purchasing a needed item for themselves, their children, spouse/ partner, or family. Amounts of \$10 to \$25 are ideal.



Q. What happens if someone takes a wish tag and loses it or is unable to purchase the gift?

A. We are so grateful for the Share community! When high-need items are not on our shelves, and a client is in need, donations of cash and gift cards from donors help us fill in the gaps.

Q. I would like a receipt. How will that be provided?

A. In-kind donations of gifts may be tax-deductible. Please send detailed donation information including name, address, and value to Brittany Hardaway at bhardaway@sharevancouver.org for a receipt.
