



## 'High Need' Wish List Program

Share's 'High-Need' wish list items are a convenient way for community members to purchase and donate a high-need item for a child, teen, adult, or senior in our housing and outreach programs to be gifted during the holiday season in December or at any time throughout the year.

**Give the Gift of Choice!** Gift cards in amounts of \$10 to \$25 provide the opportunity for people and families to purchase items on their own, which can relieve personal anxiety and boost self-esteem as they take the lead role in selecting foods to cook at home, finding just the right gift to give their child or partner, filling their gas tank or meeting their basic household needs.

**'High-Need' Wish List items should be new and unwrapped** and can be dropped off during:  
Warehouse Open Hours: Tuesdays from 10 a.m. to 12 p.m. and Thursdays from 2 p.m. to 4 p.m.

### High-Need Items this year include:

- Two-Person Tents
- Tarps
- Pots and Pans
- Small kitchen appliances such as microwaves
- Shower Shoes (all sizes, kids to adults) for people living in shelters
- Teen/ Adult sized sweatshirts and sweatpants from XS5XL
- Bedding items including pillows, sheets and blankets in sizes from twin to queen



Our warehouse is located at the Share Fromhold Service Center, 2306 NE Andresen Road, Vancouver (across from the Winco)

*Drive around to the left/ south side of the building through the black gate and ring the doorbell at the garage door.*

**Donate a Move-in Kit!** When a client or family within our outreach or housing programs is able to secure permanent housing, we try to help them be set up for success! No one deserves to come home to an empty apartment. **Build a Move-In Kit for an individual with the items listed below:**

- Bathroom Towels, including 1 bath towels, 1 hand towels, and a bath mat
- Kitchen Essentials, including 2 plates, 2 bowls, 2 glasses, and a set of flatware
- Cooking Essentials, including 1 pot, 1 pan, 1 baking sheet, and 2 cooking utensils (spatula, tongs, etc.)
- Cleaning Products, including a sponge and dish soap, all-purpose cleaner spray, and a broom
- Bedroom Necessities, including 1 pillow, 1 set of twin sheets, and 1 twin sized blanket or comforter
- Laundry Basics, including laundry soap and laundry basket
- Bonus items that are frequently asked for include: oven mits, coffee pots, rice cookers, can openers and measuring spoons/cups
