

Share 2024 *in Review*



Access to nutritious food helped households manage tight budgets and free meals sustained our neighbors living on the streets:

Backpack & Summer Meals Programs:

- 302,500+ lbs. of non-perishable food to 90 schools
- 160,000+ lbs. of fresh produce, dairy, eggs & bread at 18 schools
- 842 snack boxes to 27 local schools
- 12,093 free summer meals to kids 18 & under

Hot Meals Program & Outreach Food Kits:

- 96,987 free meals to the public
- 5,500+ food kits distributed by our Outreach Team



Local individuals and families continued to secure & maintain permanent housing:

Share's Outreach Team helped **144 people** secure housing

Share's two family shelters helped **32% of clients** move into permanent housing

Across Share's four shelters and the Winter Hospitality Overflow program, **115 people** secured housing

Our Affordable Housing and Stability program assisted **102 households**

Housing and Essential Needs program helped **115 people** with rental assistance, as well as personal hygiene products and cleaning supplies

1,350 volunteers donated their time & talent, totalling 18,443 hours

Our Talkin' Trash team removed 242.7 tons of trash from 60 local sites
